A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme

Further to the letter dated 26 May, we are writing to provide an update on the delivery of the scheme. Following the recent weekend closures, we are pleased to announce that the construction of the new Tilekiln Roundabout is complete.

An additional weekend is however required to complete the construction of the new Hadham Park Roundabout. This is due to the heavy rain in May which prevented the planned work from being carried out satisfactorily.

We are aware of the inconvenience this may cause and thank you for your continued patience and understanding.

A120 Hadham Road (Hadham Park Roundabout)

A **full weekend closure** of the road will be required for the construction of the new Hadham Park Roundabout.


The diversion route (shown on the next page) is via the A10, A414 and A1184.

All dates are subject to weather conditions and the latest Government COVID-19 guidance. We will update all signs out on the network and continue to keep our social media channels detailed below and the project webpage up to date. You can also keep up to date with all roadworks in real-time using the online **One. Network** service by searching 'Ware (Little Hadham)' to find out more.

Section 61 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974

In order to complete the work as quickly and safely as possible, we will need to start outside of normal working hours. The approval for extended hours falls under the Control of Pollution Act 1974. We continue to carry out noise and vibration monitoring as some of the work requires heavy machinery.

Update to scheduled completion of the full scheme

Following a detailed review, the bypass will now open in winter 2021 and not this summer as hoped. However, the flood alleviation scheme may be able to be operational earlier. The delay is the result of both COVID-19 working restrictions and several challenging periods of exceptionally wet weather.

Hertfordshire County Council, the Environment Agency and partners continue to work hard to deliver this important scheme which will see lasting economic, social and environmental benefits for the county for many years to come.
