A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme

Further to our letter dated 13 October, we are writing to provide an update to the delivery of the A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme.

Updated Road Closures: A120 Hadham Road

Due to bad weather forecast in November, it is no longer feasible for the team to carry out the proposed work for the new Hadham Park Roundabout. These works will now be carried out in Spring 2021 and we will keep you updated once the new dates have been confirmed. We are however planning to use one of the previously allocated weekends to carry out essential maintenance as detailed below.

Friday 13 November, 10pm	Monday 16 November, 5am	Revised closure to 14-15 November for essential maintenance
Friday 20 November, 10pm	Monday 23 November, 5am	Cancelled weekend closure


Revised Road Closure

As the highway authority, Hertfordshire County Council has a statutory duty to keep the network safe, accessible and serviceable at all times. The County Council will use one of the previously allocated weekend closures to carry out some essential maintenance including repair of the carriageway and cleaning of the drains.

Date and time of works	Impact of works
Saturday 14 November, 7am – 7pm	Full road closure
Sunday 15 November, 7am - 7pm	Full road closure (contingency if works are not completed on Saturday 14 November, e.g. due to poor weather conditions)

The road will be closed to the east of Hadham Park. The diversion route (shown on the next page) is via A10, A414 and A1184. Local residents will be able to access Little Hadham from the A10 direction.

Please note, weekday temporary traffic lights on the A120 Hadham Road will be in operation as and when required until Spring 2021 (8am-6pm).

You can keep up to date with all roadworks using the One. Network service. Type **One.Network** into your internet search engine and then type '**Ware (Little Hadham)**' into the search box to find out more. You can pick different date ranges from the drop-down menu to see upcoming works.
