A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme

We are writing to update you on the construction of the project and upcoming overnight road closures.

A120 Standon Road


It will be necessary to close the A120 Standon Road **overnight (10pm to 5am)** from **Monday 23 September to Friday 27 September** (inclusive). The road will reopen no later than 5am on Saturday 28 September.

This is part of the work necessary to create the new Tilekiln Roundabout (see map below).

A diversion route will be clearly signed via the A10, A414 and A1184 (see map overleaf). Local residents will still be able to use parts of the A120 for access to their properties (see brown sections on map).



Piling Works Update

Piling work at Albury Bridge Road, River Ash and Albury Tributary has continued longer than originally intended due to unforeseen ground conditions and is now scheduled to finish by the end of September. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by these works. We will endeavour to complete them as quickly as possible.
