A120 Post-Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme Highways Improvements: Notice of Non-Statutory Consultation

Hertfordshire County Council is investing in your community and we want to hear from you.

Following on from your feedback from the statutory consultation regarding the A120 Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme in 2014, we remain committed to creating a safer environment for your community and encouraging a greater use of sustainable transport options in and around Little Hadham.

In order to respond to anticipated changes to traffic volume and movements as a result of the new bypass, we are pleased to be proposing a number of small initiatives which we plan to introduce in two phases.

The first phase will be implemented shortly after the completion of the bypass later this year. Following the initial phase our intention is to observe the impact of the bypass on how people and vehicles use the village and identify a proposal for any further measures.

In **phase one** we are proposing:

- a controlled crossing on the A120 near to Little Hadham Primary School so pupils, parents and staff have a safe place to cross
- adjustments to traffic signals in and around the village centre to help the flow of traffic for all road users including pedestrians
- improved gateway signs as road users approach the village, to encourage people to drive carefully and reduce their speed on approach.

Phase two initiatives may include:


- enhancements to pedestrian routes and crossings
- improvements to bus stops, street furniture and landscaping.

Both phases are designed to reflect the views and needs of local people, residents and businesses, and each will be subject to a separate consultation.

The boundary of the proposed scheme is defined by the bypass roundabouts to the east and west of the village, War Memorial to the south and Albury Road junction to the north.
