NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14.2 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY 30MPH SPEED RESTRICTIONS ON CLAPGATE, ALBURY/ALBURY ROAD, LITTLE HADHAM

NOTICE is given that owing to the likelihood of danger to the public whilst the construction of the new A120 Little Hadham Bypass and associated works are being undertaken, all vehicles are temporarily prohibited from being driven at a speed exceeding 30mph on that length of Clapgate, Albury/Albury Road, Little Hadham from its junction with Upwick Green southwards and south westwards for a distance of approximately 1200 metres.
