A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme Covid-19 Impact on Planned Roadworks

Dear Sir/Madam

We are writing to inform you of some changes to the delivery of the A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme in the coming months, due to the current public health emergency.

Hertfordshire County Council is changing its roadworks programme to help keep its workers and the public safe during the coronavirus restrictions. Key repair and maintenance works will continue, to make sure that the road network remains safe for key workers, emergency services, delivery vehicles and people who still need to get to work or to the supermarket.

The County is continuing works on some improvement schemes, including the A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme, where government advice relating to construction works and social distancing can be complied with.

However, please be aware that scheduled roadworks will be subject to rescheduling and amendments in order to continue to work in line with government guidance.

Scheduled Roadworks

- Hadham Park roundabout, 30th March – 10th May 2020: **cancelled**
- Albury Road, full 24/7 road closure, 27th April – 25th May 2020: **subject to cancellation or amendments**


Notification of New Road Closure

- **The Ford, full road closure, Tuesday 7th April – Thursday 9th April 2020**

We will be closing The Ford to the south of The Smithy over a length of approximately 100 metres. The closure will be 24 hours per day for safety reasons, but work is currently planned to be carried out between 7:00am and 6:00pm to minimise noise affecting nearby residents.

During the closure, access will be maintained to The Smithy for residents, visitors and deliveries. Access is still available for pedestrians via the footpath during these works and a copy of the vehicle diversion route is shown below.

Please be aware, roadworks can change at short notice for several reasons, some out of our control.
