

## Highways Fault Reporting

The Little Hadham Parish council has formed a working party to discuss any outstanding issues relating to Highways. In order for our village to have our roads safe and well maintained, all faults need to be reported. We can follow up on these at our meetings with HCC Highways. Currently we are discussing:

- War Memorial – the damage sustained to the grass and the steps – HCC Highways are looking at the area for a feasibility of traffic calming measures. In the meantime, we will be looking to get the memorial restored
- Village sign and pump at the Ford – damage being caused to the area, looking at what options there are to resolve this – higher kerbs, fencing etc.
- Pavement opposite Hadham Hall – this is currently not safe for our litter picker to collect litter from the Millfield Lane turn off to the Phone mast at Hadham Hall. A discussion with the Bypass Team to look at clearing the footpath when the A120 is shut for bypass works.
- Old diversion signs left on the roadside
- 40 mph sign missing at Hadham Hall
