# A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme

We are writing to inform you of some changes to the delivery of the A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme.

# **Updated Roadworks and Road Closures**

#### A120 Standon Road

Temporary traffic lights will be required to continue with surfacing sections of the new Tilekiln Roundabout. Please be advised there is still further work to do before the roundabout opens to traffic.

Weekday temporary traffic lights will be active from: **Wednesday 26 August – Friday 28 August (8am-6pm).** 

### A120 Hadham Road


Weekday temporary traffic lights will be active from: **Monday 31 August – Friday 9 October (8am-6pm)**.

**Full weekend closures** of the road will be required for the construction of the new Hadham Park Roundabout. Please be advised there are still further works to be programmed to complete the roundabout prior to opening to general traffic.

The road will be closed to the east of Hadham Park. The diversion route (shown on the next page) is via A10, A414 and A1184. Local residents will be able to access Little Hadham from the A10 direction.
