### NOTICE UNDER SECTION 14(2) OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

#### TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES ON VARIOUS ROADS IN BISHOPS STORTFORD, LITTLE HADHAM, ALBURY AND UPWICK GREEN

NOTICE is hereby given that, owing to the likelihood of danger to the public whilst the construction of the new A120 Little Hadham Bypass, flood alleviation and associated works are being undertaken, all traffic is temporarily prohibited from using the following lengths of roads, except for access:-

1. that length of A120 Hadham Road, Bishops Stortford/A120 (Stortford Road/Standon Road), Little Hadham from its junction with the A1250 Hadham Road/A1184 Bishops Park Way roundabout north westwards to its junction with Warren Lane, a distance of approximately 5621 metres.
2. that length of The Ash/The Ford, Little Hadham from its junction with A120 Standon Road south westwards and southwards to its junction with Chapel Lane, a distance of approximately 1035 metres.
3. that length of Clapgate, Albury/Albury Road, Little Hadham from its junction with Upwick Green south eastwards and south westwards to its junction with A120 Standon Road, a distance of approximately 1620 metres.
4. that length of Upwick Green, Upwick Green/3U152 (unnamed road), Albury from its junction with Clapgate north eastwards and south eastwards for a distance of approximately 2075 metres.

ADDITIONALLY all vehicles are prohibited from being driven at a speed exceeding 30mph on that length of A120 Standon Road, Little Hadham from a point 314 metres north west of its junction with The Ash north westwards for a distance of approximately 1200 metres.

ADDITIONALLY all vehicles are prohibited from being driven at a speed exceeding 30mph on that length of A120 Hadham Road, Bishops Stortford/A120 Stortford Road, Little Hadham from a point 46 metres west of its junction with the A1250 Hadham Road/A1184 Bishops Park Way roundabout westwards and north westwards for a distance of approximately 2635 metres.

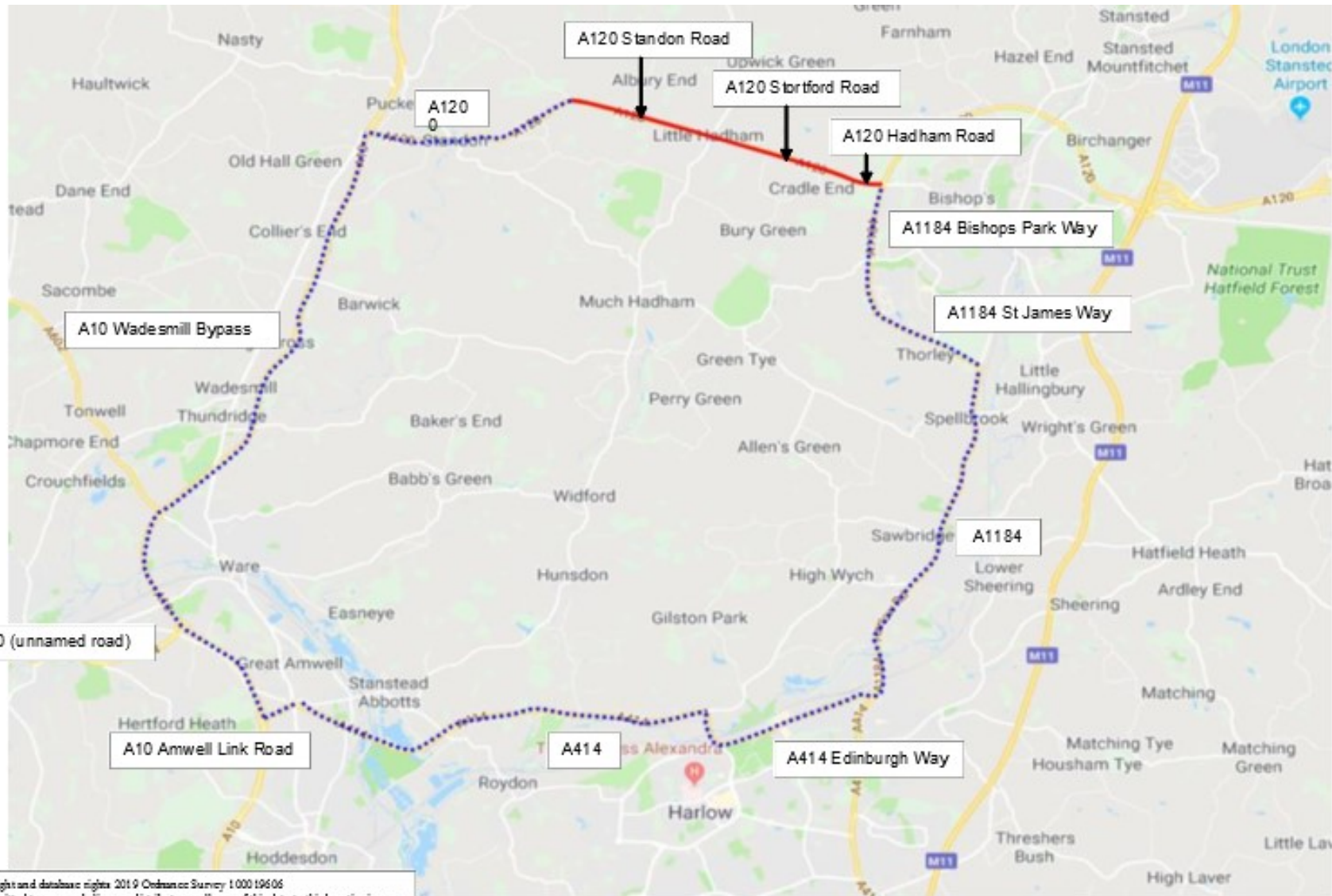

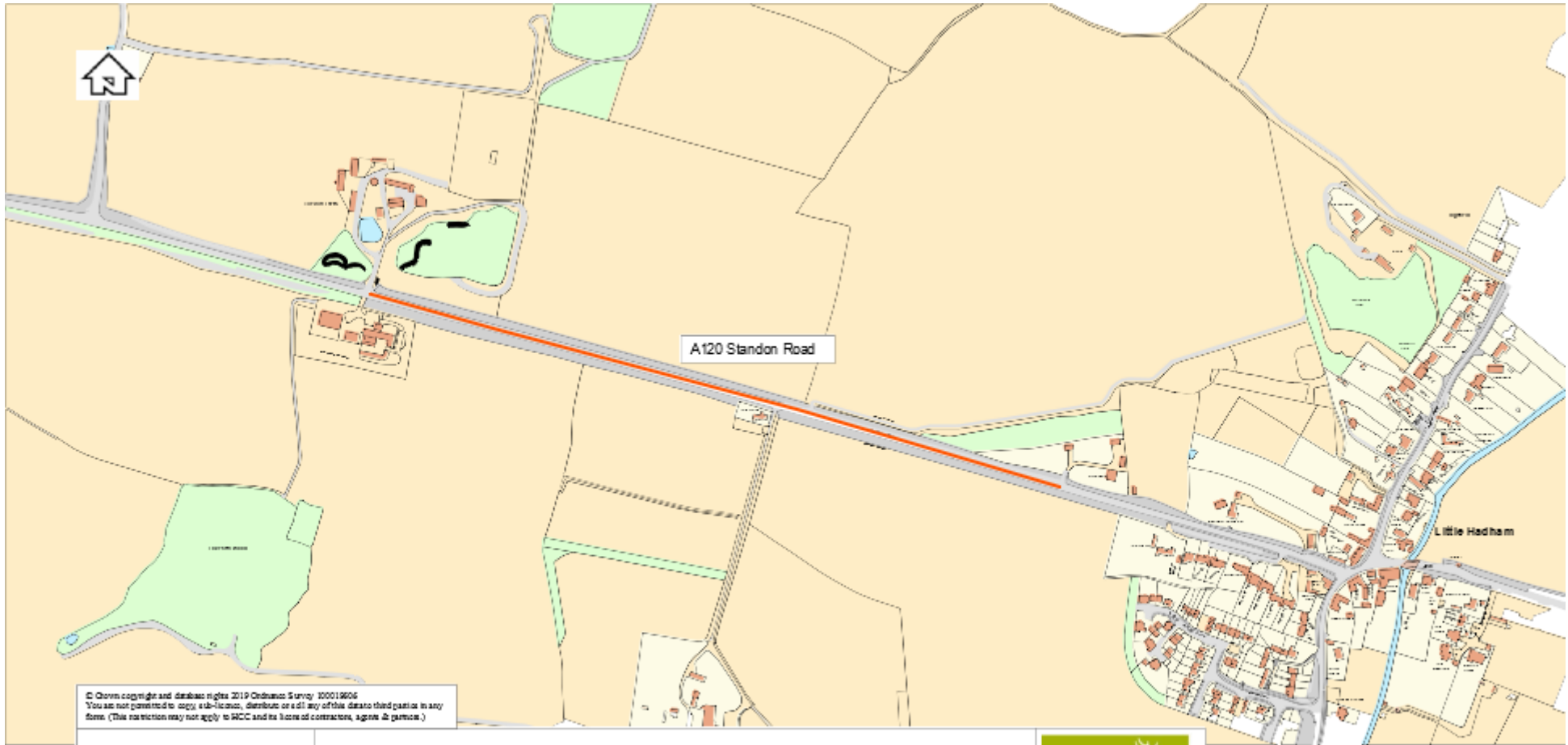

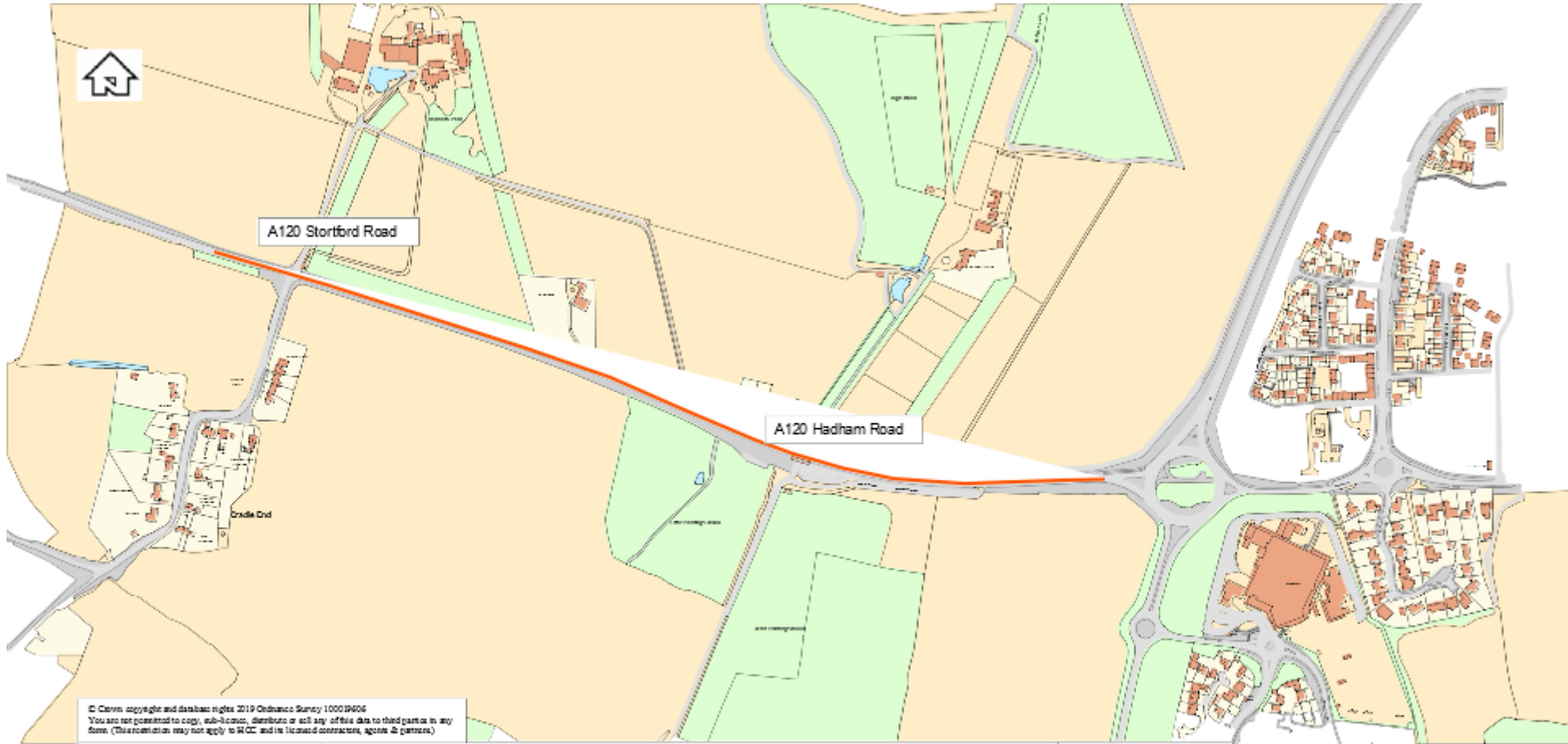
