

Westland Green – latest report

On the 4th June the Parish Council met and as part of our planning meeting voted to object to the application for a traveller site off Chapel Lane. Concurrently to the planning application process East Herts Council submitted injunctions in regard to unauthorised works.

We have received this update from Ward Councillor Geoff Williamson on this second matter:

"Since the last update, the East Herts District Council's Application Notice to commit the defendants to prison has been lodged with the High Court. This follows four weeks' work by our project team and legal advisors to collate the evidence and prepare a case. We have had great support from the police in this process.

The application will be heard at the Royal Courts of Justice, The Strand, London on 10th June. No time for the hearing has been given yet. Yesterday the defendants were served the committal papers, which included the evidence that the Council intends to provide in relation to the continued breach of the Injunction.

The EHDC will still be required to consider the planning application submitted by the defendants as this is an entirely separate process."
